Delirium series by Lauren Oliver

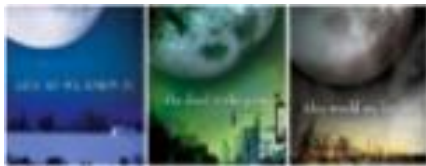
Delirium; Pandemonium; Requiem

***The Forsaken* and its sequel *The Uprising* by Lisa M Stasse**

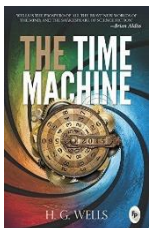

Ender's Game; Speaker For the Dead; Xenocide; Children of the Mind; A War of Gifts; Ender in Exile

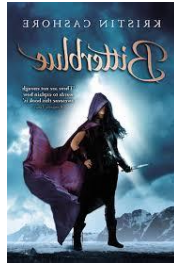
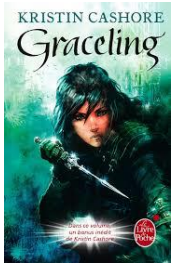

***Lord of the Flies* by William Golding**

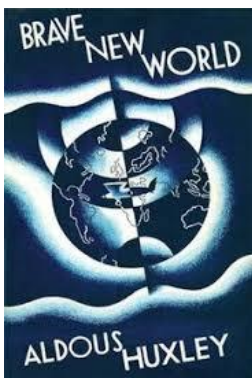

***Gone* Series by Michael Grant**

Gone; Hunger; Lies; Plague; Fear; Light

A small town in southern California: In the blink of an eye everyone over the age of 15 disappears and no one knows why. Cut off from the outside world, those that are left are trapped, and there's no help on the way. A new world order is rising and some survivors have power that no one has ever seen before...



***Brave New World* by Aldous Huxley**

Far in the future, the World Controllers have created the ideal society. Through clever use of genetic engineering, brainwashing and recreational sex and drugs, all its members are happy consumers. Bernard Marx seems alone harbouring an ill-defined longing to break free. A visit to one of the few remaining Savage Reservations, where the old, imperfect life still continues, may be the cure for his distress... Huxley's ingenious fantasy of the future sheds a blazing light on the present and is considered to be his most enduring masterpiece.



***Tandem* and its sequel *Tether* by Anna Jarzab**

Sixteen-year-old Sasha Lawson has only ever known one small, ordinary life. When she was young, she loved her grandfather's stories of parallel worlds inhabited by girls who looked like her but led totally different lives. Sasha never believed such worlds were real - until now, when she finds herself thrust into one against her will. To prevent imminent war, Sasha must slip into the life of an alternate version of herself, a princess who has vanished on the eve of her arranged marriage. If Sasha succeeds in fooling everyone, she will be returned home; if she fails, she'll be trapped in another girl's life forever.



***The Interrogation of Ashala Wolf* by Ambelin Kwaymullina**

Ashala Wolf has been captured by Chief Administrator Neville Rose, a man who is intent on destroying Ashala's Tribe. Injured and vulnerable and with her Sleepwalker ability blocked, Ashala is forced to succumb to the machine that will pull secrets from her mind.



***The Giver* by Lois Lowry**

Jonas lives safely within the Community, a place where there is no war, no hunger and no pain. When he is selected as the Receiver of memory, he starts to discover dark secrets that lie beneath the surface of his perfect world, secrets that will lead him to undertake an incredible journey.



***Gathering Blue* by Lois Lowry**

In the tough, unforgiving society that Kira lives in, she is forced daily to prove her value in the village. When Kira is summoned to judgement by the Council of the Guardians to resolve a village conflict, Kira knows she is fighting for her life.

Cinder; Scarlet; Cress; Fairest: Levana's Story; Winter; Stars Above

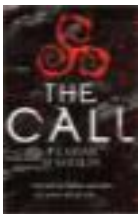
